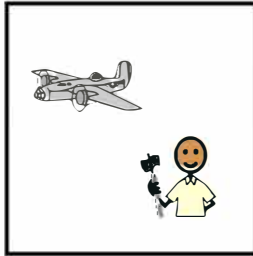

I can bring a camera to take pictures of the planes.

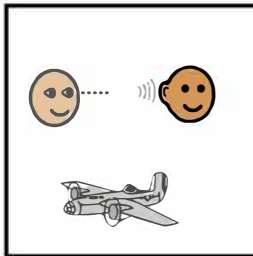

I will stay with my group and use a quiet voice inside.

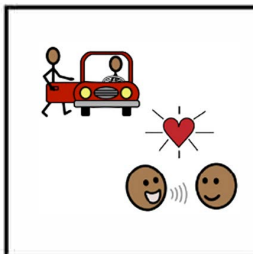
